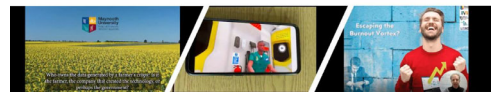


IVI Research Day 2023: Vibrant Discussion on DSRM and Research Projects

Dr. Tadhg MacIntyre joins the Innovation Value Institute

IVI is delighted to announce that Dr. Tadhg MacIntyre has joined IVI and we look forward to working with Tadhg.



Dr. Tadhg E. MacIntyre is an associate professor in environmental psychology at the Department of Psychology, Maynooth University. Here he coordinates two Horizon Projects, GoGreenRoutes and GoGreenNext. The former is a €10.48 million Horizon 2020 project (2020-2024) which promotes urban health across six European cities. The latter is a research and innovation action to help cities adapt to the challenges and opportunities of climate change (2024-2028). He studied at University College Dublin, graduating from a BA (Psych.) in 1993, continuing his studies there with a Masters degree by research in 1996 and subsequently graduating with a PhD in 2007, where he was supervised by the late Professor Aidan Moran (1957-2020). He is course leader for the MSc. in Environmental Psychology at Maynooth University.

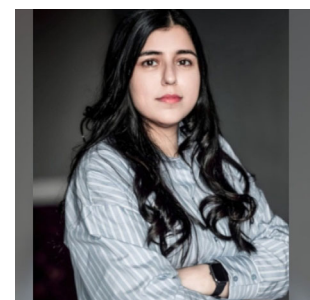
PPI Focus Group Discussion

Congratulations to Ph.D. researcher Sana Kiran-awarded Open Data Engagement Fund

The Open Data Engagement Fund has awarded funding to Sana Kiran, a Ph.D. researcher, and Prof. Markus Helfert, Director of IVI, for the project "Data Quality in Open Data Sources for Smart Mobility". The Open Data Engagement Fund has been developed with the **Open Data Governance Board** (ODGB) to promote the use of the National open data portal data.gov.ie. The funded research project dives into the intricate landscape of data quality challenges within open data sources, specifically focusing on the smart mobility domain. Through an exhaustive real-world data set analysis, we aim to shed light



on the practical implications of these data quality challenges. The core of this project lies in developing an open data quality maturity model. [Read more](#)
