Organisations across industries are facing increasing pressure to deliver accurate, auditable, and regulator-ready Environmental, Social & Governance (ESG) disclosures – often with fragmented data, unclear ownership, and evolving requirements. The Playbook helps organisations to tackle these challenges.
